We will have our Spring Fling the Friday and Saturday after Mother's Day at the Poplar Grove Location - so put Friday May 15th and Saturday May 16th on your calendar. For Kenosha, we will have the following weekend available to pick up plants for your home gardens. We will have plenty of asparagus that weekend and all the plants you want - tomatoes, all varieties, peppers, hot and sweet, basil, chard, parsley, cucumbers, zucchini, egg plant and kale. I will be open all day both days - 8 to 4:00 p.m. That way we can spread all of you out so that we will be able to comply with "social distancing" rules. I am growing lettuces in my greenhouse, I may have bags of that available with the asparagus!

Right now I am planning on a market in Kenosha on Fridays with a market in Poplar Grove on Saturday. We will send out an availability list to all of you so that you know what we will have in both locations for sale - that list will come out on Tuesdays with a short newsletter, just like this one! If we are still in the middle of a pandemic - we will find a safe method of delivery that could include ordering and paying on line and then picking your vegetables up at the designated time in each location. - This is a work in progress so keep your eyes open for further news.

We all have to think outside the box during these very different times. There is nothing more important than making certain you are eating healthy and staying healthy in the challenging days ahead.
