One of the nice things though is after I have left my impressions on my way to the greenhouse, look to the bottom right, this is what I walk into and the temperature is always in the 80s in there when the sun is out. I guess I cannot complain when it feels like spring or summer somewhere this close.

Even after this last snow and the cold weather that fol-

We were able to get quite a bit done even though the temperatures hovered in the mid 20s. Debbie B, Andy and Bill all were huge troopers. I had raspberries that I had planned on cutting back and even though the weather was freezing, they got it done and they look terrific. We filled trays for seeding these next few weeks and shelled beans from last year that will go into your first boxes. They are a variety of dried beans for soup.

I have decided to go ahead and do the early date for the Spring Fling. I really think that we will see an early arrival of my asparagus and the tomatoes (lower left) germinated great and are already a week ahead of last year - They are loving the greenhouse today, it is approaching 90 degrees in there. I actually had to open doors and put up an additional fan to keep air moving! So that date will be May 12th and 13th, both Friday and Saturday. It is Mother's Day weekend so I want to make sure that anyone that may be leaving for the weekend visit to Mom has an opportunity to stop by on Friday to buy plants, pick up asparagus, etc. I will post the exact hours next month.
