the worms type of deal, but we have plenty of things like squash, peppers and tomatoes!

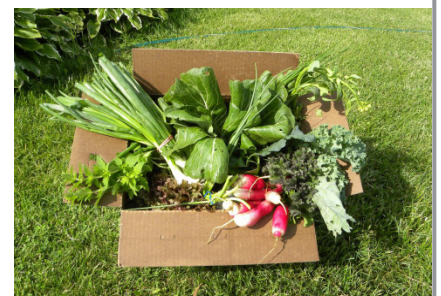
We hope to see all of you on Thursday, the 23rd for your bonus box. The set up will be from noon to 6:30. Paige and I will both be there

Items we will have are butternut squash, leftover squashes from our previous weeks, brussels sprouts and broccoli (they have just begun to put on their little heads so we are watering to make sure we have some for you). In addition to that there will be tomatoes, peppers, leeks, carrots, kale, chard. We

will open the store at this time too for any additional value added items you may want to purchase. (Cash or checks!)

We will have the store open for the next couple of Saturdays, and I will have broccoli available both of those Saturdays at no cost to 2021 Members. If you get there late on the 23rd and the broccoli is gone, come back on Saturday and we will have some for you. I planted over 100 broccoli plants, they have just been a little slow this year making nice heads. We are also taking checks, Paypal or cash (cash app too) for next year's membership. We are going to an 18 week season and offering a 9 week, every other week option for all of you at a very good LOYALTY discount. (The full price for new members in 2022 is \$640 for the 18 week and \$410 for the 9 week boxes.) These will all be the larger boxes (3/4 bushel) for the entire season. The Loyalty Member Price that is good until November 30th for these boxes is \$575 for 18 weeks and \$350 for 9 weeks. If you know of someone that wasn't a member this year and does want to sign up for next year, we will have an Early Bird Special Price for them until December 31st. Those prices are \$600 and \$375. This enables me to get a handle on the numbers for next year to help me plan the garden and order seeds. As I tell everyone each year - I am not like Dish Network - I give best pricing to my loyal customers! See you the 23rd!
