We also may have a Retail presence on Saturday - I am still firming that up and that one would include meat. Friday will have afternoon hours.

Poplar Grove store will be open on Saturdays only from 10 to 1:00 p.m. Once again, everyone will get a newsletter with an availability list for the retail store. All produce obviously is on a first come basis as I have not grown the volume of years past and with the uncertainty of 2020, I am just guessing what quantities will be needed.
